Attendance

- Attendance target = 96% and above
- You must have attendance above this point to complete this section of your passport



Rewards

- Your end of year rewards target is 800
- This is calculated using the bronze, silver and gold rewards you achieve in lessons
- You must meet the minimum target to achieve this section of your passport



Commitment to lessons

- This section is based on your behaviour and effort in lessons
- We use your school reviews to inform this
- You need to achieve above 90% A & B grades for these on your reviews to complete this section of your passport



Independent learning

- This section is based on you completing your homework
- We use your school reviews to inform this
- You need to achieve above 90% A & B grades for these on your reviews to complete this section of your passport



Community service

- Community service involves volunteering to help others
- Examples of this could be:
- Cutting a neighbours grass for four weeks
- Helping out at a primary school fete
- Doing a jobs for a neighbour for four weeks
- Community service must have supporting evidence for you to achieve this section of your passport



Extra curricular clubs

- For this section you should be attending a club inside or outside of school.
- You have to have attended this club for at least four weeks to qualify
- If you do a club outside of school, evidence will be needed to complete this section of your passport
